TUITION & FEES September 2026 – April 2027

Tuition for the course is \$12,500.00

Payment can be made by money order or check. Credit cards are not currently accepted.

- The ABAA written and clinical exam fee is included in the tuition.
- Acupuncture needles will be provided by NAAA for all clinical work.
- Tuition does not include the required texts.
- Tuition does not include a 3B Laser. Lasers will be provided in the clinicals for the students to borrow if they do not bring one.

Tuition Payment plan

Those accepted into the course will be required to make a Deposit of \$2000. Non-Refundable

The remaining tuition payment can be made in full or in 3 partial payments of \$3,500 each.

Dates for 3 payment schedules:

1ST payment by AUG 15, 2nd payment by SEPT 15, 3rd payment is due OCT 15.

Final payment must be made by OCTOBER 15.

REFUND POLICY

NAAA reserves the right to cancel the course or any of its clinical units, and to change the dates or venue of the units. A full refund can be given if the course is canceled or rescheduled prior to the first day of the course. Requests for refunds must be in writing.

- Refunds will only be given for special circumstances, such as serious medical conditions.
- When accepted into the course a deposit reserving your position in the course is non-refundable.
- If a student chooses to withdraw from the course, they must deliver notice by email or in writing their decision to either Dr. Bruno or Jay Clements
 - If less than 25% of the course has been completed – 50% refund
 - If 25% to 50% of the course has been completed – 25% refund
 - If 50% or more of the course has been completed – no refund

Travel, meals and lodging costs are not included in the course tuition. Recommendations for accommodations will be provided upon acceptance.
